Exhibitors wishing to pay the Hudson County Artists/Crafters fee must live in Hudson County and may only sell unique artwork or crafts handmade by themselves. They must provide the following items with their applications:

- documentation (business card, letterhead, etc.) that their primary place of work and/or residence is in Hudson County
- two photographs representing the items they plan to sell

Acceptable media include painting, sculpture/carving, original photography, original graphics, drawing, stained glass, blown glass, textiles and stitchery, fiber work, batik, leather, jewelry, collage, enamel, basketry, ceramics, furniture, metal, mixed media, paper, wearable art, and wood. Other recognized art or craft media will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Limit one discounted booth per Hudson County artist/crafter.

Additionally, the CASID will be awarding free booth spaces to a limited number of Hudson artists. To be considered for the free space, this application must be completed and submitted with initial payment as soon as possible.

Terms and Conditions

All portions of the Exhibitor Application form must be filled out and submitted with payment in order for the application to be considered complete.

Exhibitors will adhere to event setup and cleanup times as well as posted entry and exit traffic patterns and Jersey City Parking Authority regulations. Exhibitor booths must be set up in their entirety for the duration of the festival.

All exhibitors must have a 10'x10' canopy and at least one table. NO merchandise may be displayed on the ground. Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to attach weights to their canopies in case of windy conditions.

Exhibitors must remain in their designated space. Roving and changing spaces are prohibited.

Sharing or subletting of booths is not permitted.

Exhibitors are responsible for setting up and tearing down displays and completely cleaning their spaces before leaving.

Refunds will be issued only if a written request is received no later than **April 19, 2010**. No refunds will be issued due to bad weather or acts of nature.

Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited at the festival.

Exhibitors will cooperate with the instructions of event staff, the Jersey City Police Department and other authorities to ensure safety during the event.

Submission of a complete application does not guarantee acceptance into the event. Event sponsors reserve the right to deny applications for any reason.

Exhibitors wishing to pay the Hudson County Artists/Crafters fee must live or work in Hudson County and may only sell unique artwork or crafts handmade by themselves. They must provide the following items with their applications:

- documentation (business card, letterhead, etc.) that their primary place of work and/or residence is in Hudson County
- two photographs representing the items they plan to sell

Acceptable media include painting, sculpture/carving, original photography, original graphics, graphics, drawing, stained glass, blown glass, textiles and stitchery, fiber work, batik, leather, jewelry, collage, enamel, basketry, ceramics, furniture, metal, mixed media, paper, wearable art, and wood.
